

In the proof of Corollary 2.9, replace “ $f(m)$ ” with “ $f(a)$ ” everywhere.

In the sentence preceding Corollary 2.10, and in the statement of Proposition 2.11, replace “ $m = n = 1$ ” with “ $m = n = 2$ ”.

After defining the exchange elements in Section 3, we should say that they are a natural *specialization* of the suitable elements, rather than a generalization.
